**Community Infrastructure Levy**

The Community Infrastructure Levy is a levy that local authorities can charge on development in their area. CIL income can be used to contribute towards the funding of infrastructure needed to support new development. Here in Redhill & Northbourne Ward we are looking to use £1000 of our CIL money towards refurbishing a double decker bus at Kingsleigh Primary School. With the expansion of Kingsleigh the school has lost its reading room as it is now a classroom.
