We are delighted to let you know that we have enabled the WisePay App for our school.

The advantages of the App are that parents can store their card details (each card will need to be stored against each bank account that you use to take online payments), this will speed up checkout and also provides a 'quick top up' option for cashless catering. Once logged in to the App, parents do not need to log in again. The desktop and mobile version of your WisePay Service will remain, the App is an additional option for parents.

The App is available for download now but parents will require a KPS unique 'Organisation Code' to activate the App on their mobile.
