Parents Parking Promise – help keep our community safe

The road outside our school can get very busy during drop-off and pick-up times, which can make it difficult for children who walk, wheel, scoot, or cycle to school. That's why we're working with the Walk Wheel Cycle Trust and BCP Council to create a safer, cleaner space outside our school gates.

We understand that walking or cycling isn't always possible, and that some families do need to drive. However, by being part of our school community, we ask all drivers to follow our Parents Parking Promise. It's a simple but powerful way to show your commitment to safe, respectful, and responsible driving, and to set a great example for our children and others.

Cleaner air and healthier journeys benefit everyone. By reducing traffic and idling near the school, we can improve air quality and help protect children's health, especially those with asthma or other respiratory conditions.

By attending our school and reading this promise, you are agreeing to:

- Walk, cycle or wheel to school whenever you can. Only drive if it's really necessary.

- If you do drive, park at least 5 minutes away and walk, scoot, or cycle the final part of the journey.
- Follow the Highway Code and avoid parking on zigzags, double yellow lines, or near junctions.
- Respect our neighbours by keeping driveways, pavements, and dropped kerbs clear.
- Drive slowly and stay alert, especially near the school.
- Switch off your engine when parked, to help keep the air clean and healthy for everyone.
