We are very pleased to have been notified by the Local Authority that your child has been offered a Reception place with us for September 2021 and we welcome you to Kingsleigh Primary School. Below is some further information about starting school in September 2021 and information for the 'Open Evening' and the 'Stay and Play' sessions.

Stay and Play

We are excited to invite your child to come to school on Thursday 1 July or Friday 2 July to meet your new teacher and see what your classroom might look like. This session will take place for one hour in the afternoon and is for the child only. Parents can drop off and then collect via the Bennion Road entrance.

Your child's date is **Friday 2 July 1.30-2.30pm**.

September Start Date

We appreciate how important the transition period is for your child starting their school life. We believe that getting the children settled as soon as possible is best for them.

Your child's start date is Monday 6 September 2021 and the first week's attendance will be:

- Monday 6 September part time – more information will follow as soon as possible
- Tuesday 7 September part time – more information will follow as soon as possible
- Wed 8 September all children will be in school **9am – 12pm**
- Thursday 9 September all children will be in school **full time**



Further information regarding which class your child will be in will be sent to you as soon as we can.

Improving School Communications with ParentMail

Communicating with parents is an important part of what we do. Our provider is ParentMail and once your child is on roll in September, you will be invited to register and download their app to enable us to give you the best service we can.

Reception Year School Uniform

We currently have an amount of smaller sized new jumpers and cardigans in stock at school which we may be able to arrange a day when you can purchase here at school. **More information about this will be sent to you after the Government Update on 21 June.**

Lunchtime

Hot lunches are free for all Reception to Year 2 pupils. You can choose whether your child has a packed lunch brought in from home, a school dinner or a mixture of both. All school lunches must be ordered in advance directly from Chartwells. To order hot lunches you need to log in directly to their website where you follow the simple instructions to order meals (There is a link on our school



website). We will keep you as informed as possible regarding your child's class that you can order any required meals as soon as you can.

Milk

All children under 5 are entitled to FREE school milk. Just register online at www.coolmilk.com and select 'register my child for school milk'. Once your child reaches the age of 5 you will be notified by Cool Milk so that you may choose to pay a subsidised cost to continue milk.
